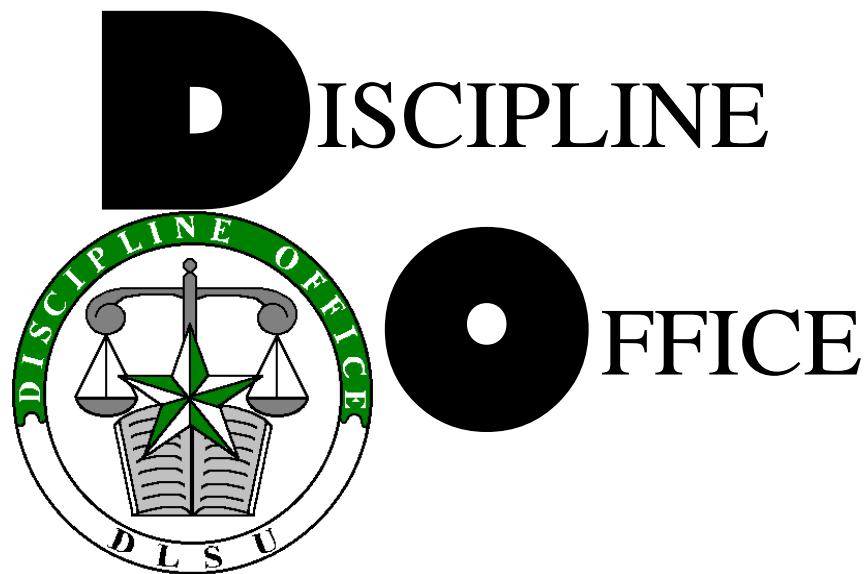

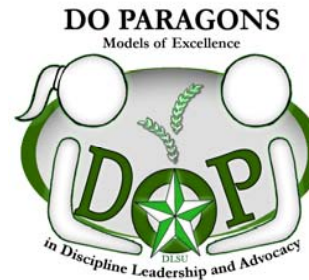

GENERAL GOALS AND OBJECTIVES
