

Xavier University – Ateneo de Cagayan



Beginnings

- Founded in 1933 as a high school named Ateneo de Cagayan by Jesuits missionary Fr. James T.G. Hayes, S.J.
- A college department was added in 1938, with course offering in Liberal Arts, Education and Commerce.
- The Grade School was started in 1940.
- Ateneo de Cagayan had 614 students when it was forced to close during World War II.

Post War Reconstruction

- From the ruins, postwar reconstruction began immediately under the untiring leadership of Fr. Haggerty and Fr. Andrew Cervini, S.J. who succeeded him as Rector.
- The College of Agriculture was started by Fr. William Masterson, S.J. in 1953 and the College of Law and the Manresa farm in 1955.

University Status

- In March 1958 the Ateneo de Cagayan received the university status and its present name, Xavier University – Ateneo de Cagayan, in honor of St. Francis Xavier.
- Today Xavier University is a dynamic institution committed to the integral education and formation of the nation's youth, especially in Northern Mindanao.
- The Commission on Higher Education (CHED) granted XU “Full Autonomy Status” for proving to be a school with passion for excellence and beyond.

University Status

- XU has four campuses:
 - Grade School in Macasandig (about 2,000 pupils)
 - High School in Pueblo de Oro and Grade School Annex (Nursery to Grade 4 also about 2000 students)
 - Manresa Complex houses College of Agriculture laboratory classes, extension programs and SEARSOLIN
 - Main Campus in Corrales Avenue – where we have about 11,000 college, professional, schools and technology students being trained.

University Status

- For now, we have six undergraduate colleges and training center for industrial technology, namely:
 - College of Arts and Science
 - College of Education
 - School of Business and Management
 - College of Agriculture
 - College of Engineering and Technology Complex
 - College of Nursing
