## APPLICATION PROCEDURES

FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2012-2013

### FOR FRESHMAN APPLICANTS

1. Fill out the Online Undergraduate Application Form and print a copy. (<http://www.dlsu.edu.ph/admissions/undergraduate/applicationform/>)
2. Proceed to the Admissions Office and submit the completed printed Undergraduate Application Form with all the required documents:
  - 2.1. Certified Correct Secondary Scholastic Records (*Download from <http://www.dlsu.edu.ph/admissions/undergraduate/forms/secondary-scholastic.pdf>*)
    - 2.1.1. Students who have graduated high school/secondary level will have to submit a photocopy of their 4th year high school report card
    - 2.1.2. International student applicants would have to submit a photocopy of their secondary school Transcript of Records
  - 2.2. Two (2) recommendations from any two of the following:
    - High School Principal
    - Class Adviser
    - Guidance CounselorUse the DLSU Recommendation Form (*Download from <http://www.dlsu.edu.ph/admissions/undergraduate/forms/recommendation.pdf>*).
  - 2.3. Three (3) identical passport photographs
  - 2.4. Photocopy of National Statistics Office (NSO) Birth Certificate for Filipino citizens or Photocopy of Birth Certificate, ACR/ICR or passport for non-Filipino citizens
3. Pay the non-refundable Admission Processing Fee of Php600.00 (Filipino Citizens) or \$50.00 (non-Filipino Citizens).
4. Present the Official Receipt to the Admissions Office and secure the Admissions Kit and Test Permit. Your entrance exam schedule will depend on the earliest testing date available upon submission of the requirements.
5. Take the exam on your scheduled date. All applicants must present their exam permits on their date of examination.
6. Results can be accessed at the DLSU website in early January 2012. Individual status letters will be mailed to the address as indicated in the Application Form in early January. If you do not receive your results by then, please inquire at the Admissions Office.

- **15 September 2011** - Submission of Application Forms and requirements

### FOR TRANSFER APPLICANTS

#### Criteria

1. Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 85% or its equivalent
2. No failure in any subject
3. No incomplete grades
4. No unofficial dropped subjects

#### Procedure

1. Email a complete copy of Transcript of Records (TOR) with previous school's grading system to [admissions@dlsu.edu.ph](mailto:admissions@dlsu.edu.ph) or submit a copy at the Admissions Office for evaluation.
2. If qualified, fill out the necessary information in the Online Undergraduate Application Form and print a copy. (<http://www.dlsu.edu.ph/admissions/undergraduate/applicationform/>)
3. Submit the completed Transferee Application form with all the required documents:
  - 3.1. Copy of the Transcript of Records (TOR)
  - 3.2. Two (2) recommendations from any two of the following:
    - Dean
    - Department Head
    - Professor
    - Guidance CounselorUse the DLSU Recommendation Form (*Download from <http://www.dlsu.edu.ph/admissions/undergraduate/forms/recommendation.pdf>*).
  - 3.3. Three (3) identical passport photographs
  - 3.4. Photocopy of the National Statistics Office (NSO) Birth Certificate for Filipino citizens or Photocopy of Birth Certificate, ACR/ICR or passport for non-Filipino citizens
  - 3.5. Certificate of Good Moral Character
4. Pay the non-refundable Admission Processing Fee of Php600.00 (Filipino Citizens) or \$50.00 (non-Filipino Citizens).
5. Present the Official Receipt to the Admissions Office and secure Admissions Kit and Test Permit.
6. Take the exam on your scheduled date. All applicants must present their exam permits on their date of examination.
