Regular Paper Submission

Proceedings and CD ROM

Conference official language is English. Each paper for publication in the AUN/SEED-Net – RC ManuE 2008 proceeding will be reviewed by independent referees and the final acceptance for publication of the submitted article is based on a majority vote of referees. Authors will be provided referee's comments when the review results are returned. A CD-ROM will be provided at the conference. A hard copy for the proceedings will be available at an additional charge and will be mailed after the conference to those who will request for it.
