

Your Guide to the DLSU Identification Card

Your Identification Card ensures our campus security.



Your Identification Card (ID) is equipped with a unique Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) chip to ensure that only authorized persons can enter the University.

- √ Tap your ID at the designated ID terminal upon entry.
- √ Wear your ID visibly whenever inside the University.

FAQs What should I do if I left my ID?

- Approach a gate with an ID Terminal.

 Security personnel will verify your identity and enrollment status.
- You will be given a one-day Campus Pass.
 The Campus Pass shall serve as your ID for the day.
- Return the Campus Pass before going home. Failure to return the pass shall incur a fine of \$\frac{7}{2}50.00\$ per day.

Do I get a minor offense if I left my ID?

Short Answer: Not immediately.

But, you may incur a minor offense if you leave your ID for a consecutive number of times either (A) within the academic year, or (B) throughout your whole stay in the University. Ultimately, it can accumulate into a major offense. Scenarios A and B below illustrate these cases.

SCENARIO A: Single Year

The 3rd and succeeding left ID infraction in a single academic year incurs a minor offense.

SCENARIO B: Whole Stay

The 6th, 8th, 10th (and so on) left ID infraction in a student's whole stay in the University incurs a minor offense.

	6 th Left ID	1 st MINOR OFFENSE

Notes: (a) Three (3) minor offenses of the same kind accumulate to one (1) major offense.

FAQs What should I do if I lost my ID?

- Approach a gate with an ID Terminal.

 Have your identity and enrollment status verified and be issued a Campus Pass. This shall serve as your ID for the day. Return this pass at the end of
- Secure a notarized Affidavit of Loss.

the day.

- This will protect you from the risk of any unauthorized use of your lost ID. Have the Affidavit notarized by a legitimate notary public.
- Request for a new ID card at The Hub.

 Bring the Affidavit and proceed to the Enrollment Services Hub at 2F Henry Sy Sr. Hall. Pay the ID fee and expect a new card to be issued in 3-5 days.

Policy on Lost IDs

The <u>first and second</u> lost ID infractions are recorded without an offense.

4 th	NO OFFENSE	Payment of ID Replacement Fee, Payment of Fine, Four (4) hours of Academic Service
5 th	1st MINOR OFFENSE	Payment of ID Replacement Fee
6 th	2 nd MINOR OFFENSE	Payment of ID Replacement Fee
7 th	3 rd MINOR OFFENSE	→ Constitutes a MAJOR OFFENSE

Notes: (b) This is paid for the issuance of a new ID card (PHP597.00).

(c) A fine equivalent to the cost of ID (PHP597.00) is paid in addition to the ID Fee.
