### Resolutions of Actual Accessions/Holdings of the De La Salle University Library

The Technical Services, headed by Ana Maria B. Fresnido, conducted a study entitled *Resolutions of Actual Accession/Holdings of the De La Salle University Library*. The study aimed to: 1) create a complete, reliable, and up-to-date accession file, shelflist file, and T-series database; (2) match the accession file with the shelflist file and the T-series database; (3) identify accession numbers which are not represented in the T-series database; and 4) have a one straight accession file with all the numbers properly represented.

The project consisted of two (2) phases. Phase I was an inventory of the accession file which was carried out by matching the accession file with the printed T-series database. Phase II was a post-inventory which was done by correcting all records found to have dis

crepancies, verifying accessions found to be duplicates and re-accessioning them when appropriate, and searching for accession numbers not represented in the T-series database.

Results of the study revealed the following:

- 1) 976 accession numbers were assigned to books twice;
- 2) 24,484 accession numbers were not represented in the shelflist file & T-series database;
- 3) 75% of 7,000 withdrawn and missing books originally classified under the Dewey Decimal Classification System matched with the list of accession numbers not represented in the shelflist file and T-series database;
- 4) two (2) accession numbers (2383 & 89312) have no accession records in the accession file;
- 5) 1,180 accession records were found to have discrepancies on their titles when matched with the T-series database; and
- 6) 131 accession numbers had been wrongly encoded in the T-series database.

The following recommendations were forwarded:

- 1) Review the accessioning procedure and formulate a more efficient one;
- 2) De-accession and re-use accession for corrective measures only;
- 3) Assign a limited number of staff to maintain the accession record and do book accessioning;
- 4) Conduct an inventory of all books to determine the total number of accessions not represented in the T-series database;
- 5) Encode the remaining accession numbers not represented in the T-series database after the post-inventory, with the accession file as the source of authority;
- 6) Provide accession records for accession numbers 2383 and 89312;
- 7) Transfer the accession records preferably in card catalog cabinets for better security; and
- 8) Print all inventoried accession records to serve as master file.

**Seminar-Workshop on Flowcharting and BPM** – All the library staff attended a seminar on "Basic Flowcharting and Business Process Mapping (BPM)" last Feb. 21 – 22 (1<sup>st</sup> batch) and Feb. 27 – 28 (2<sup>nd</sup> batch) at the Ortigas Seminar Room. The objective of the seminar was to enable the staff to "picture" the processes and activities in their sections for them to be able to identify problem areas and improve services for a better "customer-supplier" relationship. The staff prepared flowcharts and business process maps in relation to the activities their sections perform. Presentation of their outputs concluded the seminar-workshop. Ms. Rina U. Alano and Mr. Teodoro Soliva, Jr. of the Information Technology Center (ITC) conducted the seminar.

**Verzosa Conducts Training at COSE** – **Fe Angela Verzosa**, University Archivist, gave an orientation lecture on managing small libraries containing special library collections at the Coalition of Services for the Elderly (COSE), a non-profit charitable NGO last Feb. 26. COSE's library is highly specialized on materials on the aged or elderly. She also conducted a workshop on the computer applications of CDS-ISIS for its library collection.
