Circulation Section Evaluates BOOK CHUTE SERVICE: 1999-2002

From its inception on July 17, 1999 up to the present, the book chutes continue to capture increasing number of returned library books. Aimed at improving the existing policies and practices governing the operation of the book chute service of the library, an evaluation was conducted on its performance in the last three years of its operation; SY 1999-2000 to SY 2001-2002. The following is the result of the study made by the library faculty members and staff of the Circulation Section.

Total of Books Retrieved

1) The total number of books retrieved for the SY 1999-2000 was **28,778** volumes. In July, 1999 the book chutes at the South Gate and at the Library Lobby captured **60** volumes. In the next 9 months (July - March 2000) **9,000** volumes were captured.

The rapid increase was due to the installation of 3 more book chutes at the Gokongwei, Velasco and North Gates in October 1999.

2) From July to May of the School Year 2000-2001, the total number of books retrieved was **59,595** volumes, or **51.71** per cent higher than the previous year.

This can be attributed to the Library's effort in disseminating the information on the service.

3) On its third year of operation in SY 2001-2002, the popularity of the book chute service continued to rise as indicated by the **64,346** volumes retrieved

4) However, the comparison of the percentages increases between the first year to second year and second year to third year revealed a high **44.33** percent decline.

This could be attributed to the change in the library loan policy effective March 1, 2000

where *loan period* for undergraduate and graduate students was extended from one week to weeks; and for the faculty members from one month to 100 days. As a result, the returning of books, particularly on the school year 2001-2002, was not as frequent as in the previous years

Books Retrieved Per Book Chute

In School Year 2000-2001, the **Library Lobby** has the most active book chute with a total of **21,621** followed by the book chutes at the **South Gate (15,792)**, **Velasco (9,571)**, **North Gate (8,442)**, and **Gokongwei Gate (4,169)** volumes. Above trend has been revalidated during the second and third year of operation

Reduction of Queues at the Loan Counter

1) There was a total **470,816** volumes borrowed in SY 1999-2000 to SY 2001-2002. More than two thirds (**838,524** volumes or **82.53 percent**) were processed at the Circulation Counter followed by the Filipiniana and EDRC/ASRC with totals **81,237 (or 17.25 per cent)** and **1,055 volumes (or 0.02 percent)** respectively.

The book chute service has definitely reduced the queuing at the Circulation Counter by **31.44** per cent. This means that out of **470,816** loans, around **152,719** books were dropped at the book chutes.

Other Materials Dropped

Materials like **personal copies of textbooks, magazines, CDs, etc.** were also dropped in the chutes. A record of these materials is kept and a copy is forwarded to the Discipline's Office together with the privately owned items for proper disposal.

Conclusion

1) The book chute service proved to be very effective in capturing more returned books. Out of **470,816** total book loans, **152,719** volumes were captured.

2) The book chute service drastically reduces the long queue at the Circulation Counter by **32.44** per cent.

3) With the above empirical data this study concludes that the strong performance of the book chutes fully met the Library objectives:

a) *facilitating the return of library books during and especially beyond the library hours;*

b) *shortening the queueing at the Circulation Counter; and*

c) *capturing more overdue books.*

Recommendations:

1) Provide cabinet case for the wooden book chutes located at the gates to ensure maximum protection and security.

2) Come up with guidelines on the proper use of the book chute to minimize damage on books.

3) Post on the bulletin board the "List of Personal Books Returned at the BookChute".

4) Review existing practices and procedures on the operation of the book chutes periodically

5) Design survey questionnaire to gather feedback and/or better ways in safeguarding the books in particular; and in improving the service in general.

6) Keep record of the extent of damage on the books

7) Document every case and problem that will be encountered arising from the use of the book chute.

Freshmen Evaluate Second Term’s Library Orientation

Fourteen (14) faculty librarians conducted library orientation to 43 undergraduate freshmen classes from September 18 to October 28. **Yolanda Odsinada**, Head of the Readers Services reported on the evaluation given by the students.

Twenty (20) out of twenty five (25) **Library Orientation 1** classes or **631** out of **1,000** students (63.1 %) evaluated the program.

33.4 % strongly agreed and **62.12 %** agreed that the orientation gave them valuable information and adequate skill in using the Online catalog and accessing library resources and services.

60.22% agreed and **22%** strongly agreed that the orientors have effective communication and presentation skills.

93.49 % found the orientation relevant and **96.19 %** recommend the orientation to be carried out for the incoming freshmen students.

Twelve (12) out of eighteen (18) classes evaluated the **Library Orientation 2** program.

71% expressed that the orientation has definitely gave them adequate knowledge of the research tools and varieties of research methodologies necessary to access information.

76.81% found that accessing the OPAC and the search techniques to be the most valuable information they received. **80%** expressed confidence and readiness in conducting research as they have learned and understood the research processes.

96.68% recommend the program to be conducted for next year’s students.
