**Ms. Perla T. Garcia** and **Dr. Raymund Sison** represented the De La Salle University in the first ASEAN University Inter-Library Online (AUNILO) Working Committee meeting. It was held last April 28-30 at the Phoenix Hotel in Singapore with the theme "Growing People: Training and Developing New-Age Information Professionals for Academic Libraries. The meeting was hosted by the Nanyang Technological University (NTU). The AUNILO Working Committee was organized subsequent to the resolution reached by the senior librarians and IT experts of the ASEAN University Network (AUN) during their conference at the De La Salle University Library in September 2002.

In his welcome address, **Professor Brian Lee**, Director of the International Relations Office of NTU, emphasized the needed core competencies for the current developments in automation, digitization, open access, connectivity and networking in universities and libraries. Dr. Raymund Sison presented the summary report on the AUN's collaborative research project "Software Development and IT Training in 5 ASEAN countries". The study focused on the basic software process strengths and weaknesses of some

## Valenzuela Conducts Training at La Salle-Roxas City

**Cresencia B. Valenzuela** was invited by **Dr. Rosemarie Montañano**, the EVP of the La Salle Affiliate School in Roxas City, Capiz to train their faculty on the use and production of the overhead projector (OHP) transparencies and PowerPoint presentation. The three and half day training was held from April 12 to 15 and was attended by the teaching faculty of all levels. On the use of the OHP and transparencies, the

The seminar was capped with the teaching demonstration of each one using the techniques they learned.

software development firms in Malaysia, the Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, and Vietnam. It was found out the software development firms in the region is strong in Software Requirements Management (SRM) but weak in Software Quality Assurance (SQM). Five recommendations were given: adoption of Software Quality best practices; development of courses or curricula to improve Software Education program; conduct more researches on the weaknesses; strengthening ties between the academe and software industry; and to further study on the suitability of the Capability Maturity Models to firms in the country/region. In his paper "Growing people: global trends and developments in training and education" **Mr. Tan Khay Quee** contrasted the traditional with the emerging trends in training and education as driven by the changes in the workplace, changes in roles and jobs and shifts in role relationships.

Ms. Garcia chaired the review and re-formulation of the AUN resolutions reached in Manila last September

2002. The AUNILO Working Committee re-affirmed the tasks agreed in the original resolutions and formed a Secretariat. For the period of five years (2005 - 2010), the Universiti Sains Malaysia Library shall serve as the AUNILO Secretariat, while the University Malaya Library shall host the AUNILO Portal and set up communication facilities such as listserv, mailing list, discussion group, and newsgroups. The Committee shall meet at least once a year to plan, prepare, and assess activities and strategies and activities

for the mutual benefit of member libraries, develop and sustain human resource development programs among the members, and harness ICT in the promotion, maintenance, and enhancement of programs and activities of the AUNILO. The Committee meeting in 2005 will be hosted by the Universiti Sains Malaysia and the 2006 meeting will be hosted by the University Brunei Darussalam Library.

The members visited the NTU Library and the National University of Singapore Law Library. The various information service capabilities in both universities were demonstrated.

## **The Baguio Sojourn: A Wish Come True**

Everything started as a wish – and the rest is history.

Holding annual planning workshops before the current school year ends, so we could start the incoming school year right and with focus, has been a practice at DLSU. As early as January of 2004, **Perla T. Garcia**, the Library Director, asked the librarians to scout for a place that would serve as a venue for the library's workshop. One staff

Driven by excitement and inspiration, **Claire Tagasa**, Circulation Librarian, went to Baguio to look for the possible venue and make necessary arrangement for catering service.

So on a very hot Saturday afternoon of April 17<sup>th</sup>, the happy group consisted of seven members of the Library Management

Committee (LMC), 39 library staff, and 5 guests boarded a Victory Liner bus for the sojourn to the City of Pines. The bus was soon filled with chatters, booming laughter as the male staff did their tricks, and also snores from those who chose to sleep.

By 10:30 P.M., the group arrived at the Firmd Vacation House at 12 Maryhurst Road. After settling for about 30 minutes, Ms. Garcia led the group downtown to the Session Road to sip hot coffee and ate Dunkin' Donuts. Later, the staff formed their own groups and went to their place of preference. Others went home to rest and prepare for the next day that promised to be a hectic one for everybody.

Sunday morning was packed with energy and vitality. As early as 4 o'clock A.M., many were up and about and ready to hear Mass at the Cathedral and to explore the city. The scheduled places to visit were the Strawberry Farm at La Trinidad and the Bell Church. However, the staff were given the prerogative to choose the places they wanted to visit. Some went to the Wright Park because they wanted to see horses, some went to Camp John Hay, others to the Botanical Garden, and the Grotto, while a few contented themselves with buying pasalubong at the City Market. The whole afternoon was also left for the staff to decide on how they were to spend it. Some went for more sight-seeing; other had their siesta; while some spent the whole afternoon chatting. Most of the staff went to SM Baguio in the late afternoon. There they watched the city scenery while feeling the cool Baguio breeze. It was late in the evening when almost everyone saw each other.

The next day, April 19<sup>th</sup>, was an official day. This was the day for everyone to visit PMA and Saint Louis University (SLU). Aboard three jeepneys, the group arrived at PMA for the 8:30 A.M. appointment with Col. De Leon. They felt proud and excited as they read the big marquee welcoming them to PMA.

A VIP treatment was experienced by the whole staff in their whole stay at the PMA. Col. De Leon met them at the Vicente Lim Hall and they were led to the Valor Room. Here they saw pictures and background of the Medal of Valor awardees mounted on the wall. At the Melchor Hall, a short PowerPoint presentation about the history, admission procedures, curricula of the PMA was given and a brief film showing about a day on a cadet's life was shown by **Lt. Colonel Danilo H. Desuasido**, the Director of Cadet Admission. A short question and answer portion followed. Among the questions raised were "How does the PMA mould its cadets to strengthen their loyalty to the government?" "How do you discourage coups d' etat?" and "What are the qualifications for admission to the PMA?."

During the tour of the library it was observed that the PMA Library has expanded both in space and collection; some of their Filipiniana books could not be found in the DLSU collection; the arrangement of their collection was very orderly; and the military books could impress even kids of preschool age. The Museum which showcases the former PMAers was also visited. Everyone seemed to be very interested in the statues inside the building and had their photos taken in front of them. Then Col. De Leon led the group to the sacred ground, where the cadets' drills take place. It was unfortunate that we

came in on a Monday where drills were not done. Col. De Leon explained that cadets' "pass in review" drills are performed every Saturday mornings. After lunch, buying mementos, and the photo sessions in front of the marquee, the group headed for Saint Louis University (SLU).

The uphill climb toward the library building of SLU was so tiring but it was all taken away by the warm reception of **Mr. Vir Fuerte**, SLU Library's Director for Technical Operations. The SLU Library was a typical library that seemed to transport the DLSU personnel way back in college where they had to settle with a closed-shelf policy of lending books. The closed-shelf system helps maintain the orderliness of the place as well as prevents the occurrence of or even eliminates losses. The visit to the museum was very entertaining and educational. Various farming tools were displayed, skulls of ancient upland people were exhibited, various religious statues were flaunted, while some preserved animal parts were put on view. The museum visit was followed by a video presentation by Mr. Vir Fuerte about the SLU Library.

The visit to the two libraries gave the staff learning experiences much more than they could have learned from books and from discussions in a classroom. The time spent with the library faculty and with their fellow staff made each one realize and be aware of the other talents of others in budgeting, in cooking, and the like. And that no matter how loud some snore and after sleepless nights because of that, they can always see humor in every situation, which made their stay a very enjoyable and memorable one.
