the issues and concerns in managing an e-library such as integration of information resources that will provide network and wider access of library collections. 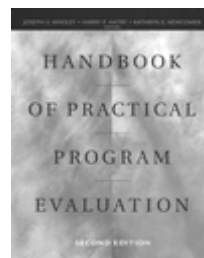
Written by Paul Kenneth Wright, expert in manufacturing processing operations, robotics, expert systems, open-architecture control, rapid

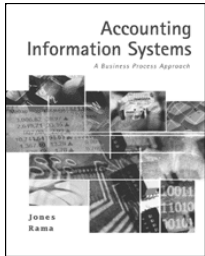

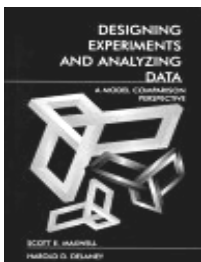

The encyclopedia includes approximately 425 photographs and seventeen maps. A list of internet sites is also provided to guide readers to the sites where additional information on selected articles in the encyclopedia can be found. Finally, the topics covered in the encyclopedia, including those that are not headwords themselves are indexed.

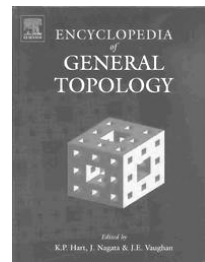
