



Operational Plans for SY 2006-2007

Under the leadership of Ms. **Perla T. Garcia**, University Library Director, the **Library Management Committee**, composed of the Unit and Section Heads, conducted its annual planning workshop this April. In line with the University's Ten Year Development Plan, which is now on its fourth year of implementation, the committee drew up the library plans for SY 2006-2007 based on the following areas of concern: academics, research, human resources, services, linkages, finances, and physical facilities.

Top of the list under academics is the establishment and the further development of digital library, highly specialized research collections, and a state-of-the-art information infrastructure by introducing current information technologies for users and staff. PAASCU recommendations for CBE, CLA, CED, and COS will be followed up.

Under research, project studies will be conducted like user focused assessment of online resources, complete assessment



databases, continuing the update of periodicals holdings in the database, filling up the gaps of the print journal subscriptions, and updating the Reference webpage. There is also a need for information literacy program through self-directed information guides and search paths on specific and multidisciplinary

of the entire book collection, e-metrics for use of resources, and formulation of collection development policies for Instructional Media Services (IMS) and Circulation Section. Linkage with research centers within De La Salle University-Manila & other universities will be undertaken. Selected archival records will be digitized; the President's records will be prioritized.

For the library's human resources, emphasis will be given to the competency of the IMS personnel in rendering media services, continuing staff and professional development program for a more computer literate personnel to ensure needed competencies and maximize job performance, the licensure of the assistant librarians, and management training program for key administrators.

In the area of service, there is a need for maintaining accurate in-house

research topics.

Under linkages, emphasis will be placed on the strengthening of the gifts and exchange program and the library linkages with the ASEAN University Interlibrary Online (AUNILIO) and learning centers in the Asia-Pacific and with the consortium member libraries. These will be done by creation of set policies and procedures, by attending the annual meeting of the AUNILIO and participation in cooperative project or program and by conducting training workshop on topics related to ICT application in libraries.

For finances, there is a need for a permanent, sustaining library endowment, financial assistance from funding agencies, individual and other potential benefactors for collection development.

Under the area of physical facilities, the priority is the establishment of the

The other member schools are the Technical University of the Philippines (TUP) –Visayas, Bacolod State College, and San Agustin College. One of its projects is information building capability and sharing resources using information communications technologies and information

access and delivery.

Upon the invitation of **Brother Rolly Dizon, FSC**, who spearheaded the consortium, **Ms. Perla T. Garcia** visited the member libraries and conducted a seminar entitled “**Digital Library: a face lift or a phase leap to better service**” on April 20 and 21. Ms. Garcia's lecture focused on the various forms of electronic information resources, the different types of databases and their technological, economic, psychological and organiza-



tional concerns. She extensively discussed the Philippine e-library; its collaborators, its objectives and salient features as potential tool for e-resources. She also demonstrated how one could join and access the resources at <http://www.elib.gov.ph/>.

Fresnido and Tagasa Attend Seminar on Preservation Management

Ana Maria Fresnido, head of the Technical Services and **Claire Tagasa**, the Circulation-Reserve librarian attended the three (3) day Seminar Workshop on “*Preservation Management: Setting Up a Preservation Program For Libraries and Archives*” held on April 3-5, 2006 in Davao City. The seminar, sponsored by the Society of Filipino Archivists (SOFIA), dealt

with the causes of deterioration of various archival and library materials and introduced ways on how to retard deterioration and preserve these materials as well. Workshops on basic material preservation and development of preservation programs for libraries and archives highlighted the seminar.

General Education Library at the new Andrew Gonzalez Hall. Selected materials cited in the syllabi of courses for General Education will be the initial collection. Sectional areas will be improved for better visibility and functionality. More mobile compact storage systems and modular service desks will be constructed to augment shelving space requirements at the Information-Reference section and the Archives Sections. Metal book chutes will be fabricated to replace the old wooden ones. Computer facilities and equipment will be upgraded and electronic services will be expanded. A second server for the Millennium system will be purchased as back-up. Museum pieces need to be relocated to another building for expansion of shelf space and the reading area.

Ladlad & Valerio Attend Seminar on ICT

Marita Valerio, Bibliographic Librarian, and **Jocelyn Ladlad**, ASRC and EDRC Librarian and President of the Association of Special Libraries of the Philippines (ASLP) attended the seminar on “Information Communication Technology (ICT) for Libraries: Trends, Security & Ethics” sponsored by the ASLP. The two-day seminar was held last April 27-28 at Kimberly Hotel, Pedro Gil, Malate.

The seminar started with the Keynote Speech by **Dr. Bruce Armstrong**, the Cultural Attache of the US Embassy. This was followed by the presentation of the ICT’s concepts and trends and its current use in libraries and information centers by **Ms. Placida Limpin** of the Assumption College. **Mr. Edgar Quiros** of UP

Diliman discussed how to address the ICT security concerns. **Ms. Claire Ching** talked on the free and open source software in the library. How to develop an ICT Project to meet library needs was clearly discussed by **Mr. Brian Co**, the Director of the DLSU’s Information and Technology Center. **Ms. Milagros Ong**, Chief Librarian of the Supreme Court presented the pros and cons of Digitizing while **Ms. Patricia Ann Floro**, the General Manager of Floro International Corporation, illustrated the processes of digitizing documents, and explained the advantages and disadvantages of analog and digital materials. **Ms. Jocelyn Ladlad** - presented the ethical issues that affect the librarians work environment.
