



Highlights on Library Services in School Year 2005-2006

The school year 2005-2006 proved to be another challenging and fruitful year for the library faculty and staff. They were able to plan and accomplish relevant programs and activities, streamline policies, develop collections, hone their skills, and continuously upgrade and improve their various services.

Collection Development

With its budget allocation for capital expenditure of P31.6M (Library-P26.2M; IMS - P5.18M and EDRC-P0.161M), the library was able to purchase much needed books and multi-media equipment, continue to maintain the Millennium system and subscribe to on-line journals. There were 5427 volumes (4819 titles) of books, 430 titles of print journals, 911 volumes of AV materials, and 126 units of assorted media equipment purchased. With the continued application of the Millennium, the full implementation of the inventory module was made

possible. The on-line journal subscription was expanded with the addition of Political Science database, I-Stat, and Philosophy Index. The full operation of the remote access facilities to on-line electronic subscriptions took effect thus allowing the DLSU library users to access on-line subscriptions off-campus or at the comfort of their homes. For the instructional media facilities and equipment, ten (10) additional multimedia projectors were installed at Velasco Bldg. and ten (10) television monitors on the classroom walls at the Miguel Bldg. For circulation purposes, 20 more laptops, 10 multimedia projectors, 24 microphones, 6 wireless microphones, 9 overhead projectors, 10 portable voice amplifiers, 10 VHS/DVD combo players, and 16 portable screens were purchased. The mini electronic classroom at the 2nd floor of the IMS was in full operation this school year.

Staff Development

The librarians continue to develop in their chosen field either through their unwavering institutional commitment, studies, research, and sharing their

expertise, thus earning them awards and promotions. This year's Medrano Service Awardees (for 25 years of dedicated service) were **Amelia Maula**, **Renato Abellera**, **Florbella Bongalos**, and **Julie Arcilla**. **Claire Tagasa** and **Marita Valerio** were given permanency status after passing the three year probationary period. **Ana Fresno** was promoted from ASF II-6 rank to ASF II-7. Likewise, **Robert Vallente** was promoted from being a clerk to assistant librarian. **Harold Franco** of the Archives passed the librarians' licensure examination. **Vivian Soriente** and **Jojie Gonda** graduated with their Master of Library and Information Science (MLIS) degree from the University of the Philippines Institute of Library Science (UPILS) this summer.

Immersion Visit of CHMSC Librarians

The Carlos Hilado Memorial State College (CHMSC) librarians namely **Misses Cynthia Malefecio, Ruvy Tubles, Ma. Lorela Cayao** and **Mr. Raymund Cayao** spent a 3-day immersion visit at De La Salle University Library from May 22-24, 2006 in anticipation for the digitalization project of the college. The project is a direction made possible through the Negros Islands Consortium with Higher Education and Business Inc. (NICHEs).

The 3-day onsite immersion and training activity was designed by **Ms. Perla T. Garcia**, Library Director. **Ms. Elizabeth B. Padilla**, Periodicals Librarian, served as the training coordinator. The immersion attempted to provide the participants the basic knowledge and competencies on the following areas: identification and utilization of the various access tools to digital resources such as OPACs, search engines for fee based subscriptions, internet information sources; formulation of basic and advance query statements for information retrieval; familiarization with the different search system platforms or architecture in terms of the online subscription services at DLSU Library; sourcing of

sample information resources pertinent to the needs of the library represented and exploration of the automated library operations being implemented at DLSU Library.

On the first day, Ms. Garcia gave a brief introduction on the coverage of the visit and the expected output. Ms. Padilla gave the bibliographic instruction at the mini E-classroom with the hands-on exercises accessing the DLSU homepage, online subscriptions and other databases. Searching and retrieval tools and systems were done such as searching, printing, downloading and sending search results via-email, and preparation of a sample bibliography on the specific topic related to the school's curriculum. On the second day, the participants continued working on the

pathfinder on their assigned topic of research using OPACs and other resources at the Information-Reference Section. They also observed the various automated library operations such as the check out and check in procedures at the Circulation and Filipiniana sections, processing of reserve materials, online indexing of articles, the LAN of digitized theses collection and the organization of the La Salliana publications and special collections, and the technical processing of materials such as accessioning, acquisition, cataloging, bar coding and labeling. They also took pictures of shelves, magazine display rack and other pieces of furniture as bench marks for their libraries.

On the third day the librarians finalized their lists and reports and further observed the automated acquisition and cataloging process and media booking modules. The wrap-up session was made in the afternoon. The participants were able to present their individual work output which includes the results of their search results, lists of websites for free access to e-books or full articles, a sample of a pathfinder or a webibliography on a chosen subject or topic. Because of the limited time the final report on the action plans to be initiated in their library was sent via e-mail to P. Garcia. The final session was completed by the distribution of certificates and a photo session.

She also lectured on "Digital Libraries: a Face Lift or Phase Leap to Better Service" at the Carlos Hilado College, Bacolod City, April 21, 2006 and on "Innovative Services and Future Challenges for Libraries" at La Trinidad, Benguet, May 17, 2006. Ana Fresnido discussed on "Revolution of the Cataloging Process", for PAARL members at

Island Cove, Cavite on October 18, 2005. **Cresencia B. Valenzuela** had been actively involved in training the DLSU faculty members in the use of PowerPoint in instruction, one of the modules at Center for Educational Multi-Media (CREM). She also handled the "Harry Power: a Seminar on PowerPoint" and "Advance PowerPoint" for the DLSU students held at the Yuchengco Bldg. on June 22, 2005 and at the E-classroom on Feb 22 respectively. She was a part-time lecturer for the EDP 713 (Production of PowerPoint Presentation) class at the DLSU- College of Education. Jocelyn Ladlad delivered a lecture on "Ethical Issues in ICT" for the ASLP at the Hotel Kimberly in Manila on April 28, 2006. **Fe Angela Verzosa**, on the other hand, talked on "Library Linkages/ Networking" at UST Library on August 26.

Studies/Reports

For this year, the librarians were able to make a study on the strengths and weaknesses of the book collection,

prepared the inventory report, and streamlined collection policies. Collection Development Policies for European Documentation and Research Centre (EDRC), American Studies Resource Center (ASRC), Periodical Section, and College of Science were prepared. The library book collections were assessed using the check listing method against the BBAL Science, Technology, Agriculture (vol. 1), Medicine (vol. 2), History & world history (vol. 5), Philosophy, and Religion (vol. 8). Documents and exhibits for COE PAASCU re-survey were prepared.
