After 20 years of dedicated service to the university as public programs coordinator and media specialist, Ms. Cresencia B. Valenzuela officially retired on August 31, 2007.

Ms. Cres, as she is fondly called by her colleagues in the Library, joined DLSU in 1988 and was initially hired as Head of the Instructional Media Services (IMS). Her being creative, resourceful, and good conversationalist made her the first public programs coordinator of the DLSU-M Library in 1996. As the public programs coordinator, she took charge of promoting the

The SMI-IC (previously I-IC) was established in 1974 to serve as an instrument for the maximization of institutional resources among its member schools which was originally composed five members, namely the Philippine Christian University, Philippine Normal University, St. Paul University-Manila, St. Scholastica's College, Manila, and the De La Salle University-Manila. It has now expanded its membership to twelve institutions to include, Adamson University, De La Salle-College of Saint Benilde, Emilio Aguinaldo College, Lyceum of the Philippines University, Philippine Women's University, Technological University of the Philippines and the University of the Philippines-Manila.

Dr. Salazar is a well known expert in the field of social science, including anthropology, history, and psychology. His contribution to the field of social science is made evident by his numerous publications. He was the former Dean of the College of

Social Sciences and Philosophy of the University of the Philippines, Diliman and finished his Doctorate in Ethnology in Cultural Anthropology at Sorbonne Universite de Paris. He also taught Philippine psychology at the De La Salle University-Manila.

The collection will be part of the Library's Special collections which will be housed at the University Archives.
