



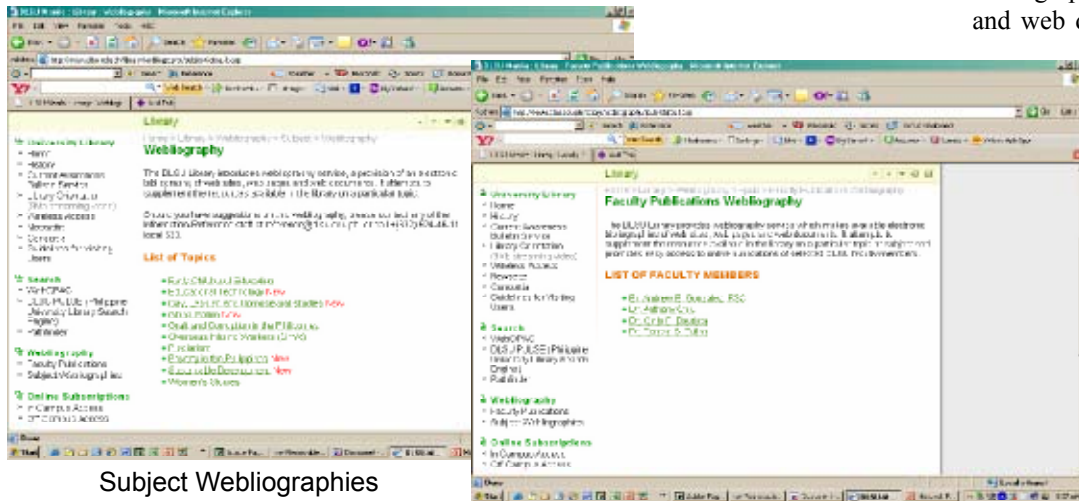
Webliography Usage

which has reached 14, 949 from the time it started until September 2007.

Webliographies are electronic bibliographies of web sites, web pages, and web documents. These are created

in an attempt to supplement the resources available in the library on a particular topic or subject. The first subject webliography posted on the Library's homepage was on the topic *Graft and Corruption in the Philippines* which proved to be the most frequently used webliography having been accessed 9,553 times since the time it was posted in July 2005. The topics on *Early Childhood Education* (which was accessed 2,098 times from August 2005 to

September 21, 2007) and *Poverty in the Philippines* (which was accessed 888 times) occupied the 2nd and 3rd ranks

The creation of webliographies is a service introduced by the DLSU-Manila Library in school year 2005-2006. Being the first and only library in the

Philippines that provides webliographies to library patrons, such service has benefited a number of researchers as shown in the number of transaction logs

The Br. Benedict Learning Resource Center

The management of the Br. Benedict Learning Resource Center (BBLRC) located at the 18th floor of the Br. Andrew Gonzalez Hall was turned over to the University Library by Dr. Beeching Ong of the Science Education Department on August 23, 2007. The

Center occupies a floor area of 160 square meters and has a seating capacity of 42 library patrons. It has a viewing room which can accommodate 20 people. It houses books and audiovisual materials and equipment donated by the Natividad Galang Fajardo Foundation.

The collection which is composed of 1,201 volumes of books, 887 titles of DVDs/VCDs/AVDs/CDs, 125 teaching modules and other print resources is now being cataloged and classified and will be made available to the community upon completion of the processing. For patrons who want to do personal viewing of videorecordings, 7 television sets with DVD players are also available.

The policies of the University

Library will also apply to the BBLRC. Ms. Cynthia L. Cordova, Head of the Andrew Gonzales Hall Library-IMS, was designated to be in-charge of the Center.

respectively in terms of usage (see Table 1)

This school year, 2007-2008, it has expanded the service to include webliographies of faculty publications, with the objective of promoting easy access to online publications of selected DLSU faculty members. The first two webliographies of faculty publications prepared were that of Br. Andrew Gonzalez FSC and Dr. Tereso Tullao. In less than three months, Br. Andrew's webliography has already been accessed 179 and that of Dr. Tullao's logged 212 (see Table 1). In September 2007, faculty publication webliographies of Dr. Cirilo Bautista and Dr. Anthony Chiu had been posted.

3rd Rizal Library International Conference *From Classroom to Career: Roadmaps to a Library's Success* by Harold Franco

The 3rd Rizal Library International Conference *From Classroom to Career: Roadmaps to a Library's Success* was held at the Escaler Hall, Science Education Complex, Ateneo de Manila University Loyola Heights Campus, Quezon City on October 22-23, 2007. Among the DLSU participants who attended were Yugosto Balbas, from the Circulation Section, Harold Franco from the University Archives, and Agnes Barsaga from the Technical Services.

During the first session of the conference, the following papers were presented by different speakers on the subtopics *Service Friendly Librarians: Challenges and Opportunities* and *"Multiform Resources and Services: Transforming the Library:*

1. *Surfacing Filipino Children's Images of Librarians through Doodling* presented by Dr. Allan B. de Guzman, Professor, University of Sto. Tomas
2. *Learning to Learn: the Ultimate Outcome for Young and Old Alike* presented by Dr. Ann M.

Riedling, Associate Professor, School Library and Information Technologies, Mansfield University of Pennsylvania

- Information literacy is the main focus of the paper. The abilities to access, evaluate, organize and use information have become the skills necessary to function in the current world, and with the role of librarians as good decision makers they can be help in understanding when information is needed, where it can be found, and how it can be evaluated.
- 3. *Faculty-library Collaborative Practices in Teaching in the Sri Lankan Universities* by Nayana Darshani Wijayasundara read by Dr. Lourdes T. David
- A study on collaborative practices between the library and faculty in the Sri Lankan university system.
- 4. *The Theory of Human Caring and Service Friendly Librarians* by Susan E. Higgins read by Dr. Riedling
- A reflective essay that analyzed Jean Watson's Theory of human caring in the context of service friendly librarians.
- 5. *Clientele Recognition of Library Terms and Concepts Used by*

Librarians: a Case of an Academic Library in the Philippines presented by Dr. Allan B. de Guzman

- The study dwelt on the ability of college students to recognize terms and concepts used by librarians, using a multiple choice type test.
- 6. *Why Not Change Libraries' Position of Supply Chain? A Conceptual Model for Leaguuing Libraries and E-resource Industry* presented by Chiou-shu J. Hwang.
- The paper presented a conceptual model for building a supply-chain partnership between the Library of the Institute of Technology and the electronic resource industry in Taiwan benefiting the faculty, students, librarians and e-resource industry through practical and effective blueprints for purchasing and presenting e-resource and offering new services of promoting the knowledge product of the faculty and students of Institute of Technology.
- 7. *Design and Development of a System for Remote Access to Book-accompanied CD-ROM's Using Open Source Software at Central*

Library, IIT Kharagpur presented by B. Sutradhar

- Described the need for remote access to book-accompanied CD ROM's at IIT libraries and presented the tools and techniques in designing and developing such system.

The sub-themes on the second day were: 1) *Servqual, libqual +, e-quality accreditation: assessing service quality* 2) *Library theory and research: an imperative challenge* 3) *Handling local materials* 4) *Collection development in a free access environment* and 5) *Service-friendly librarians: challenges and opportunities*. The following papers read during the day were:

8. *Management Strategies for Delivering Quality Library Services* by Khaiser Nikam

- The paper reported on the study on the strategies for delivering quality library services in engineering college libraries of Karnataka, India affiliated with Visvesvaraya Technological University.

9. *Library Service Quality of Pustaka Negeri Sarawak, What Do the Users Say?* by Nagarajah Lee Hun Leong

- Focused on the assessment and identification of user's perceptions and expectations of the services

provided by PNS.

10. *From Classroom to Career: Lessons Learnt from Using Citation Analysis as a Research Tool in a University Library* by Adriaan Swanepoel.

- Described the positive and negative lessons learnt by the library of a university of technology in South Africa after conducting a citation analysis study.

11. *Questions and Challenges in Establishing and Maintaining a Local Studies Center: the Case of the Cavite Studies Center* by Emmanuel Franco Calairo

- The paper discussed the historical development of the Cavite Studies Center of DLSU-Dasmariñas, highlighting the reasons of its existence, its vision-mission, operations, programs, projects, linkages, issues and the problems confronted by the center in promoting local culture, and community levels.

12. *Filipiniana Online: Collection Development in a Free Access Environment* by Vernon R. Totanes

- Introduced and identified Filipiniana resources freely available online.

13. *Possibilities of Minimizing Acquisition Costs and Accumulating Comprehensive Research Materials*

through Collaborative Resource Sharing Among Libraries by Marcia Czarina Corazon M. Medina

- The paper looks at the use of online resources, like journal databases, in the natural sciences of programs (physics, chemistry and biology), of two Philippine universities, and the use of these online resources opposite printed journals.

14. *International Best Practices of Service-friendly Librarians: Fresh Perceptions from a Year-long Comparative Analysis of U.S. and Asian-Pacific Librarians* by John Hickok.

- Discussed in detail the specific challenges and opportunities including model best practices of both Asian-Pacific libraries and those in the West (U.S., Canada, Europe, etc.)

Overall, the conference appeared to be highly informative and insightful, having introduced resources and methods which could be applied to libraries. It also provided clearly the roles and characteristics of librarians in honing an information literate society, and has fostered camaraderie among the participants.

National Seminar-Workshop on 3rd Generation Library Management : Realities and Challenges to Deal or not to Deal

Sponsored by the Philippine Association of Academic and Research Librarians (PAARL), the national seminar-workshop on *3rd Generation Library Management : Realities and Challenges to Deal or not to Deal* was held at Hotel Sea Breeze, Bacolod City on October 17-19, 2007.

Ms. Jocelyn Balangue, the current PAARL treasurer and Head of the Acquisitions Section, together with Ms. Elizabeth Padilla, Head of the Readers' Services Unit, Mr. Rolly Masindo and Ms. Julie Arcilla, Circulation and Filipiniana assistant librarians attended the said seminar.

The keynote address was delivered by Hon. Evelio R. Leonardia,

mayor of the City of Bacolod. The first session was conducted by Ms. Florenda G. Don-Santos, Chief Economic Development Specialist of NEDA Library, covered a three part topic which included the following: *Beyond Leading and Managing : Library Administration for the Future; Bridging the Gap: Core Competencies; and Effective Communication for Librarians and Information Professionals*. The second session on *Intensifying Library Resources in an Environment of Change*, was delivered by Ms. Loreto T. Garcia, a certified PACUCOA accreditor and currently the university librarian of the Jose Rizal University (JRU). According to her, libraries, institutions, organizations and other agencies should be able to cope

with rapid changes brought about by technological revolution and concluded that the only permanent thing in this world is change itself. The last session on *High Tech Marketing : New Ways to Promote your Libraries* was conducted by Ms. Hinie S. Gonzales, the university librarian of the University St. La Salle, Bacolod City. She emphasized that libraries should be efficient, flexible, attractive, functional, barrier free and expandable and ended her talk by saying "the marketing of libraries will be much more rewarding and effective if it includes marketing of librarians and professional library services. After all, a building full of books is not a library without a librarian."

Seminar-Workshop on Research in Librarianship : Challenges, Competencies, and Strategies

Libraries advance as the world advances. With research, libraries are able to keep pace with these advancements and improve library services.

Sponsored by the Philippine Librarians Association, Inc. - Southern Tagalog Region Librarians Council (PLAI-STRLC), a seminar-workshop on *Research in Librarianship: Challenges, Competencies and Strategies* was held at La Vista Resort, Pansol, Laguna on October 9-10, 2007. It was attended by more than 50 participants including 4 library personnel from De La Salle University Library -Manila namely, Willian S.A. Frias, Head of Technical Services and concurrent Collection Development Librarian, Bob Cauilan, Assistant Librarian of the Acquisitions Section, Wilfredo Frias, Assistant Librarian of the Information-Reference Section, and Jorge Bundalian of the Periodicals Section.

Ms. Fe Angela Verzosa, former DLSU Library Director and University Archivist, delivered the first paper entitled *Conducting Research in Librarianship: an Overview* where she emphasized the importance of research in librarianship. She attributed the reason of not having a good number of researches in librarianship to the poor reading behavior of librarians who, if given time to read at least an

article a day, might be driven to produce researches of their own. She explained the problems, issues, approaches and trends in library research and recommended to include reading library literature at least once a day as part of every librarian's job description to encourage and promote conducting library research.

Mr. Vernon Totanes, PhD student in Library and Information Science,

University of Toronto, Canada and MS graduate of UP-SLIS, in his paper "*Research Methods Applicable to Library and Information Studies*", explained different methods in conducting research and cited his own researches as practical examples to do such. He provided list of authorship from the Asia and the Pacific Region in Top Library and Information Science Journals as overview of the status of library research in the Philippines compared with other Asian countries.

Ms. Elvira B. Lapuz, UP SLIS-Diliman Faculty and Head of UP Main Library, Acquisitions Section talked about "*Research Style Manual, Proposal Writing and Research Funds and Grant Seeking*". She emphasized the importance of management support in library research and shared tips on how to successfully gain support and acquire financial grants in conducting research.

In her paper, "*Statistical Treatment and Analysis of Data*", Ms. Elsa T. Silon, Director of Research and Development Department of the Colegio de San Juan de Letran, Calamba, identified some statistical tools use in research and their applications and explained the process of analyzing the treated data that will be used in making either an effective future predictions or

making sound-decisions.

Ms. Milagros Santos-Ong, Library Services Chief, Supreme Court of the Philippines, on the other hand presented "*Copyright Law: Issues, Concerns and Cases*". She cited related issues, concerns and cases on copyright in the Philippines and abroad and reiterated the roles of libraries and librarians on how to protect the rights of the authors and researchers against copyright violations.

Lastly, the *PLAI and Board for Librarians Updates* were presented by Mrs. Susima L. Gonzales, PLAI Board National President.
