



Librarians Pass Licensure Exams

Three (3) assistant librarians of the DLSU-Manila Library recently joined the roster of licensed librarians in the country, namely, Jojie A. Gonda and Romnick Henric Henry M. Gayanillo, who both passed the Librarian Licensure Examination given on November 26-27, 2007, and Julia W. Arcilla who qualified for the licensure without having to take the examination.

Ms. Gonda, assistant librarian at the Cataloging Section, finished her Master of Library and Information Science at the University of the Philippines-Diliman in April 2006. Prior to her masteral studies, she took Specialization in Library Science at the Philippine Normal University which she completed in April 2000 and BSBA major in Commerce at the Pamantasan ng Makati which she finished in 1995. She

joined the DLSU Library in July 1997 where she started as a library clerk who was in-charge of producing catalog cards. Her job as card production clerk inspired her to pursue Library Science courses and awakened her interest for cataloging.

On the other hand, Mr. Gayanilo, a newly hired contractual assistant librarian, who is also from the Cataloging Section, is a fresh graduate of Bachelor of Library and Information Science at the Philippine Normal University. In August 2007, four months after he graduated, he was immediately hired by DLSU Library.

Ms. Arcilla or Julie to her friends has served DLSU in various capacities for 27 years. She was initially hired as a library clerk in 1979 and became the secretary to the Head of the Readers'

Through the Internet, the Library's collection development librarian, Ms. Willian S.A. Frias, was able to solicit donations from the *American Mathematical Society* in Lancaster, Philadelphia, USA. The Society donated 34 boxes of journals to the DLSU-Manila Library containing issues of *Mathematical Reviews* dating back from 1949 to 2006 including the annual indexes

accompanying the issues. The handling fee of all the donated items which weighs 900 kilos was also shouldered by the Society. The Library was also assured of book donations.

Another valuable donation was received from a De La Salle alumna, *Mr. Antonio Sebastian Araneta*, which consists of rare books on: 1) Philippine

Library Director Attends the 4th AUNILO Committee Meeting

Ana Maria B. Fresnido, the Library Director, represented the DLSU-Manila Library during the Fourth AUNILO Committee Meeting hosted by the Center of Academic Resources, Chulalongkorn University, Bangkok, Thailand, on November 22-24, 2007. Except for Myanmar, all member libraries sent their representatives including the three (3) new member libraries namely, Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia, Institut Teknologi Bandung (Indonesia) and Mahidol University (Thailand).

The objectives of the 4th Meeting were as follows:

1. To present the progress of the library operations of the AUN member universities, specifically on the knowledge and information management;
2. To exchange and share knowledge, viewpoints, and experiences on resource sharing, human resources development, and the use of information and communication technologies in university libraries; and
3. To formulate plans and strategies for cooperation among member libraries.

Dr. Susanne Ornager, advisor for Communication and Information in Asia of UNESCO, Bangkok, was invited to serve as resource speaker and delivered a paper entitled *Knowledge and Information Management: Strategies*

and Practice. After which, the delegates presented institutional reports on the theme *Knowledge and Information Management*. A. Fresnido reported on the experience of the DLSU-M Library with regard to knowledge management (KM) focusing on the KM initiatives of the University Library which include, among others, the creation of the Library's homepage; the establishment of the Library Management Committee; user education program; training of trainer's program; mentoring; formal and informal training; documentation of programs and procedures; and, consortia and linkages. Based on the institutional reports presented, it was concluded that all member libraries embark on knowledge

management at different levels.

The meeting proper was held on the second day where the proposals for the training needs and expertise of the member libraries were discussed. A task force consisting of members from Indonesia, Singapore, and the Philippines was commissioned to revise the proposals presented following the AUN format.

For the Committee's collaborative projects the body was informed that the glossary of library science terms in English is now accessible through the AUNILO portal (<http://202.185.96.188/aunilo/default.asp>). To serve the purpose of having the terms translated in the

Ms. Marita G. Valerio, Bibliographic Control Librarian, served as resource speaker in a seminar sponsored by the University of the East Library Alumni Association Inc. (UELSAAI) entitled *Enhancing Reader's Services Through Technology* which was conducted on November 9, 2007, at the Ortigas Foundation Library. In her presentation, Ms. Valerio discussed the procedures of creating webliographies and explained the essential criteria in the selection of websites, web pages, and web documents. The forum was attended

by nearly a hundred participants composed of librarians, students, and other information professionals from the different libraries and information centers in Metro Manila and nearby provinces.

Likewise, Ms. Jocelyn Ladlad, the American Studies Resource Center (ASRC) and European Documentation Resource Centre (EDRC) librarian was also invited to lecture on *Customer Care* in a seminar-workshop sponsored by the Association of Special Libraries of the Philippines (ASLP) with the theme *Library Management in the Midst*

of Technological Innovations which was held in Tagbilaran, Bohol from November 7-9, 2007.

During the *1st Inter Lasalle School Librarians' Conference* which was held on November 22-24, 2007 at the Retreat House of La Salle Greenhills, Ms. Ladlad was again tapped to present a paper on *Deconstructing the Librarians Myth*. Her paper dealt with the roles librarians have to play in realizing the mission-vision of the school. The conference was attended by representatives from member school libraries of the De La Salle-Philippines.

Library Personnel Attend Forum on *Strengthening Interpersonal Relation and Service Attitude Competencies of Library Staff*

Vivian Soriente, Circulation librarian, Annabelle Aliwalas, Filipiniana librarian, Purisima Fernando, Head, Cataloging Section, together with Robert Vallente, Edwin Padilla and Ulysis Fadrillan of the Technical Services Unit attended the PAARL sponsored forum entitled *Strengthening Interpersonal Relation and Service Attitude Competencies of Library Staff* on November 27, 2007 at the Multimedia Room of San Beda College, Mendiola,

Manila. The resource speaker, Dr. Conrado Iñigo, Dean of both the Graduate School of Business and College of Business Administration Of the Lyceum of the Philippines presented the habits on how to improve the capabilities and personal attributes of frontline library staff in dealing with diverse patrons through proactive and client-focused approaches of providing quality information services. Based on Stephen Covey's book entitled *The seven habits*

of highly effective people: restoring the character ethic, Dr. Iñigo enumerated the habits that every employee should practice (i.e., be proactive; begin with the end in mind; put first things first; think win/win; seek first to understand; synergize and sharpen the saw) as well as the cores of credibility which are character (integrity and honesty) and competencies (capabilities & results). He also discussed how to market libraries.

Seminar-Workshop on Conservation of Documentary Heritage Collection

Recognizing the importance and urgency of conserving the documentary heritage collection, the Society of Filipino Archivists, Inc. in cooperation with the National Commission for Culture and the Arts conducted a three-day live-in seminar-workshop held in Pearlmont Inn at Lim Ket Kai Drive, Cagayan de Oro City on October 22-24, 2007. A total of 177 archivists, conservators, curators, records officers, librarians, administrative staff in-charge of records, secretaries and other heritage professionals/workers from Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao attended the seminar-workshop.

The ten invited speakers are

known experts in their respective fields and most had been trained abroad. Addressing the problems of conservation, the lecturers emphasized the factors that contribute to the deterioration of documentary heritage collection.

The seminar proper was given in a nutshell focusing on the conservation of the different types of collections common in libraries, archives and museums. Among these materials include the widely paper based type of records (e.g. books, journals, letters, maps, paintings, legal documents, musical scores, manuscripts, scientific drawings, etc.); films; and photographs. The lectures focused on paper conservation and also

discussed other preservation methods like microfilming and digitization and stressed that microfilming is still considered to be the best method of conservation.

Overall, the seminar-workshop provided the participants: 1) understanding of the material nature of documentary heritage and the environmental requirements for their preservation; 2) a know-how in diagnosing common documentary heritage degradation and deterioration; 3) new knowledge in applying first aid treatments and simple conservation/restoration measures; and 4) increased awareness on some issues and problems concerning conservation of documentary heritage collection.

different languages spoken by the member libraries, it was suggested that a database be developed. Member libraries were reminded to take part in translating the terms to their native languages. It was also noted that the University of Malaya is currently working on the possibility of having a federated search facility for the AUNILO member libraries. To date all the websites of member libraries had been visited/checked and it was found out that most of the systems are Z39.50 compliant.

Report on the usage of the AUNILO

portal was also presented. Based on the statistics, the portal has been visited 2,260 times since it was created in January 2006 and 73.76% of those who visited the site were from Malaysia. Because of the very low usage rate of the portal in other member countries, member libraries were requested to provide a link to the AUNILO portal through their respective library homepages.

The Universiti Sains Malaysia was also requested by the body to continue

to serve as the AUNILO Secretariat with Mrs. Sofiah Hashim as the chairperson.

Vietnam National University-Ho Chi Minh will be hosting the 5th AUNILO Meeting which is tentatively scheduled in November 2008. The theme of the next meeting will be *Library Services of AUNILO: Towards Integration*.

Seminar-workshop on Library Management in the Midst of Technological Innovations

The Association of Special Libraries of the Philippines (ASLP), Inc. sponsored a *Seminar-workshop on Library Management in the Midst of Technological Innovations* on November 7-9, 2007, held at the Dao Diamond Bed and Breakfast, Tagbilaran City, Bohol which was attended by more than 70 librarians from all over the country. Four of whom were from the DLSU-Manila Library namely, Annabelle Aliwalas, Filipiniana Librarian, Purisima Fernando, Cataloging Librarian, Yolanda Odsinada, Reference Librarian, and Jocelyn Ladlad, Head of ASRC and EDRC, who was also one of the speakers.

Customer Care was the first topic presented and was delivered by Ms. Jocelyn Ladlad where she discussed on the different dimensions of quality service which are: physical environment, reliability, responsiveness, courtesy and communication. Librarians were reminded to be efficient, honest, and polite to the library clientele, and to provide the right information at the right time. She ended her presentation by quoting James H. Donnelly, Jr.—*“Customers cannot be satisfied until they are not dissatisfied. Our first service priority should be to eliminate all opportunities for dissatisfying*

customers because they are what cause customers to leave. Then you can invest in satisfying and delighting them”.

The paper of Dr. Marilou P. Tadlip, Library Director of the University of San Carlos, entitled *Trends in Collection Development in Today’s Technology-Driven Library* was read by Ms. Milagros Santos Ong, Library Director of the Supreme Court of the Philippines, which gave an introduction on the knowledge and skills needed by librarians to create and maintain a collection that supports outstanding library service.

The topic on *Cataloging and Classification of Information Sources* was delivered by Ms. Corazon Nera, Chairperson of the Board for Librarians, Professional Regulation Commission, which discussed on Machine-Readable Cataloging (MARC) and the AACR 2 R, 2002 edition and its application to Filipiniana materials and other library materials.

Indexing in the Midst of Technological Innovation was the paper delivered by Ms. Milagros Santos-Ong, where she shared her observations on the changes or adjustments being adapted in the basic indexing principles. According to her, a more liberal outlook in indexing terms should be applied and stressed that despite the advent of computers and all

technological innovations, librarians and/or information specialists remain to be the king or queen of the library since decision and supervision still rest on the librarian.

The topic on *Library & Information Resource Centers Administration and Library Standards* was jointly discussed by Ms. Corazon Nera and Ms. Milagros S. Ong. Ms. Nera also explained the Code of Ethics for Librarians and cited the different library administration cases being handled by the BFL.

Part of the seminar was an environmental scanning activity which gave the participants the opportunity to visit the different tourist attractions of Bohol such as the old churches and museums, well-known beaches, the Hinagdanan Cave, the historical Blood Compact statue, and the famous Chocolate Hills.

The seminar was very informative and provided the participants insights on how to further improve library services in order to satisfy library users and how to effectively and efficiently manage libraries with the emergence of new technologies.

The DLSU-Manila librarians were able to select 500 volumes of academic books from the said donation which would form part of the general collection and will be placed either at the Main Library or its branch library, the Andrew Gonzalez Hall Library. Only the handling fee was shouldered by the Library.

National Congress on *Developing Competencies: Challenges and Issues* by Cynthia Cordova

The Philippine Library Association Inc. (PLAI) sponsored a three-day National Congress on *Developing Competencies: Challenges and Issues* held at the Angelo King International Conference Center in Malate, Manila on November 12-14, 2007. One hundred forty seven (147) participants from different school/college/university libraries all over the country attended the Congress including three of DLSU-Manila librarians namely, Cynthia Cordova, Jojie Gonda, and Casilda Manongsong.

Dr. Nilo L. Rosas, Commissioner Professional Regulation Commission delivered the keynote address where he stressed that librarians should be globally competitive and should possess the four core group of competencies such as philosophical, professional, technological, and personal competencies.

Professor Corazon Nera, Director of Libraries of the Lyceum of the Philippines University and Chairman of the Board for Librarians discussed on *Library Education: Issues and Concerns vis-à-vis R.A. no. 9246*. She enumerated the scope of the practice of librarianship and discussed the Librarian's Licensure Examination and gave details on the qualifications

for applicants, and the places and the dates of the upcoming examination. She also mentioned the salient points of R.A. No. 9246 and later presented the members of the Board for Librarians and explained their functions, duties and responsibilities.

The topic on *Counter-Disaster Management in Library Services* was handled by Professor Salvacion M. Arlante, University librarian of the University of the Philippines, Diliman, discussing on the different types of potential disasters and salvaging priorities where she emphasized human safety as the first priority.

Ms. Emma Rey, Executive Director of Congressional Library Bureau House of Representatives, discussed on the topic *Managing Disasters in Libraries : Collection* which focused on the Philippine disaster scenario and presented some cases on Disaster Management in Library/Archives. She also provided suggestions in enhancing the capability to manage disasters.

Ms. Marianita D. Dablo of the Mindanao State University, Marawi City, talked on *Widening the Circle of Influence of Librarians and Information Professionals: Practitioners Perspective* and

introduced librarians on the concept of the term influence and presented the different approaches to influencing people.

Partnering Professional Competencies of Librarians was the topic presented by Professor Thelma Kim, Vice President and Conference Chair of PLAI, where she explained how librarians can develop and strengthen partnership with the customers and enumerated the keys to a lasting customer relationship.

Director Agnes Padilla of the Human Resource Development Office handled the topic *Widening Circle of Influence of Librarians and Information Professionals: Administrators* where she explained the different strategies to widen circles of influence.

The General Assembly for the Philippine Librarians Association, Inc. members followed after the seminar.
