

## 2013 Taiwan Scholarship Offerings

### I. Types

#### 1. Huayu Enrichment Scholarship (HES)

This one-year language scholarship is for students who wish to undertake Mandarin language (Huayu) courses in the Republic of China (Taiwan). Each year, 5 students are chosen to receive the scholarship. They will each receive monthly stipend of NT\$25,000 (approximately P36,000) to cover tuition fees, board & lodging, and other expenses.

#### 2. Taiwan Scholarship

The Taiwan Scholarship is for students who wish to pursue a Masters or Doctorate degree in a university in Taiwan. The program duration is 2 years for students in the Masters program and 3 years for those in the Doctorate program. Each year, 10 students are chosen to receive the scholarship. They will each receive a monthly stipend of NT\$30,000 (approximately P44,000) to cover tuition fees, board & lodging, and other expenses.

### II. Eligibility

An applicant must meet all of the following criteria:

- a. Be of 18 years of age or older, a college graduate or above
- b. Be a Filipino citizen (must not have Taiwanese citizenship or a Taiwanese passport)
- d. Is not currently a registered student at a Mandarin training center or a degree-seeking student at any university or college in Taiwan.
- e. Is not an exchange student in accordance with an agreement of cooperation between an international university/college and an educational institute in Taiwan, at the time of receiving an HES.
- f. Has never received an award under the HES program or the Taiwan Scholarship Program.
- g. Is not a recipient of any other scholarship or subsidy offered by the Taiwan government or any other educational institutions in Taiwan.

### III. Requirements

1. One copy of the completed application form (can be downloaded from [www.taiwanembassy.org/ph](http://www.taiwanembassy.org/ph))
2. One photocopy of the passport or other nationality certificates
3. One certified true copy of the highest-level diploma
4. One copy of complete transcript of records with CGPA (cumulative grade point average) indicated
5. Proof of application to a Language Center/ University in Taiwan (e.g. reply from the school that application for admission has been received, or courier receipt)
6. Two (2) Letters of Recommendation from previous or current University Professors and/or Employers
7. Interview (to be arranged after completion of application documents)
