The Student Personnel Services (SPS) of De La Salle University – Manila sponsors and organizes the Student Awards to recognize the outstanding performance of student leaders, artists, writers, athletes, organizations and student organization advisers.

The Gawad Mag-aaral also aims to provide models of service, excellence and teamwork and concern for others – individuals who exemplify the values, skills and behavior of a Lasallian achiever for God and country.

A student may apply for the award if the following qualifications are met:

1. A bona fide undergraduate student of DLSU-Manila (*for Bishop Felix Paz Perez Award, all faculty advisers of student organizations under Council of Student Organizations, Cultural Arts Office, Office of Sports Development and Student Publications Office)
2. No record of major and/ or minor discipline offense; no pending case with Discipline Office
3. No failing grade during the following terms:
3rd term of SY 2006-2007
Summer term of SY 2006-2007
1st and 2nd terms of SY 2007-2008

Qualified students will be judged based the following criteria:

1. Leadership – A student’s leadership ability will be assessed based on his/her major achievements, projects /activities organized, positions held in the organizations/groups etc.
2. Academics – All candidates are primarily students of the University. The Cumulative GPA (as of 2nd term of current school year) of students is a vital requirement in the evaluation and screening of candidates
3. Service – Community service is one of the major criteria in identifying the finalists and awardees of Gawad Mag-aaral. The service component will be assessed based on the nature of involvement of students in social engagement activities or projects.

Note: Weights of each of the criteria varies per category/award.

Process of Application

Any individual in the university may recommend /nominate himself/herself, a student, or a faculty adviser as nominee for this year's Gawad Mag-aaral. When a student is nominated for a certain award or category, the following are the steps that should be taken to become a finalist for Gawad Mag-aaral.

Step 1: Get information kits and application forms from the following:

Office of Student LIFE (SPS 301) from January 7– 11, 2008
Lasallian Pastoral Office (SJ 101) from January 7-11, 2008
Central Plaza from January 7-11, 2008

Step 2: Make sure to submit the following documents to the Screening Committee c/o Ella Soriano SPS 301 on or before January 19, 2008:

1. Accomplished application form (based on the format prescribed) and two (2) recommendation forms sealed in a brown envelope with the corresponding label (Name, ID, Category). Please do not forget to attach a 2x3 formal photo in the application form.
2. Soft copy of resume e-mailed to Ms. Macy Eusebio at eusebiom@dlsu.edu.ph.
3. E-mail also to Ms, Macy Eusebio at least five (5) digital photos (300dpi) in action (depicting what you do in the organization and/or showing outreach activities)

Step 3: A list of nominees who made it through the paper screening will be released on February 21, 2008. A letter will be sent to inform you if you qualified for the Panel Interview Phase. If your name appears on this list and you did not receive a letter, call Ms Ella at local 732 for verification.

Step 4: Arrange your Panel Interview schedule with Ms. Ella on or before March 15, 2008. Please be at your interview schedule on time.

Step 5: After the Panel Interview, make sure to attend the Gawad Mag-aaral 2008 awards night on June 27, 2008. Attire will be **FILIPINIANA**.
