**RESOLUTION CALLING FOR DE LA SALLE UNIVERSITY STUDENT COUNCIL TO  
RELEASE THE LETTER ASKING THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO  
ENDORSE THE IMPEACHMENT COMPLAINT.**

Whereas, the Legislative Assembly is the highest policy making body of the Student Council (Article VIII Section 1, Student Council Constitution);

Whereas, the Legislative Assembly shall concern itself with discussing and deciding resolutions on national and sectoral issues (Article VIII Section 4, Student Council Constitution);

Whereas, the De La Salle University Student Council has called for the resignation of President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo through Resolution No. 2005-09;

Whereas, the La Salle Brothers released their statement entitled "Restoring Faith and Democracy" calling for the resignation of President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo July 3, 2005;

Whereas, President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo delivered her State of the Nation Address on July 25, 2005 without reference to any scandal involving her administration (The Philippine Daily Inquirer, July 26, 2005);

Whereas, the Opposition congressmen filed an amended impeachment complaint that had 42 signatures out of the required 79 (The Philippine Daily Inquirer, July 26, 2005);

Whereas, the House of Representatives has already agreed on the rules of impeachment (The Philippine Daily Inquirer, August 2, 2005).

Wherefore, be it finally resolved that the Student Council President forward the letter to the House of Representatives.
