**RESOLUTION CALLING FOR THE APPROVAL OF THE RESIGNATION AND
DECLARATION OF VACANCY OF ONE SEAT FOR THE COLLEGE OF
COMPUTER STUDIES – CATCH 2T8 LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY
REPRESENTATIVE AND LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY FLOOR LEADER**

Whereas, the Legislative Assembly, being the highest policy making body of De La Salle University Student Council, has jurisdiction over all matters concerning the policies, rules, and operations of the De La Salle University Student Council;

Whereas, Batch Representatives and the Legislative Assembly Representatives shall be voted into office by members of their respective year level of their respective college (De La Salle University Student Council Constitution, Section 6, Article XV);

Whereas, Legislative Assembly Representative shall perform their functions as stated in Section 3, Article VIII of the Student Council Constitution;

Whereas, the term of the De La Salle University Student Council elected officer shall begin on the last day of the preceding school year and end on the last day of the same school year (De La Salle University Student Council Constitution, Section 2, Article XVI);

Whereas, a student council officer may end his or her tenure only when impeached or upon tendering his or her resignation to the Legislative Assembly (De La Salle University Student Council Constitution, Section 12 and 13, Article XV);

Whereas, Mr. Francis Lou L. Siasat, Legislative Assembly Representative of CATCH 2T8 has tendered his resignation effective January 14, 2006;

Whereas, members of the De La Salle University Student Council shall be all undergraduate students of the regular programs of DLSU (De La Salle University Student Council Constitution, Article II);

Whereas, Mr. Francis Lou L. Siasat will be taking a leave of absence on the third term of school year 2005-2006;

Whereas, when an elected officer files a Leave of Absence from his/her responsibilities as a student to the university, the elected officer should pass a resignation letter to the Executive Secretary, President and Ethics Chairperson. The resignation of an officer should be approved by the Legislative Assembly in an open session; (De La Salle University Student Council Officers Code of Conduct and Responsibilities, Section 3.4, Article I);

Whereas, the College Assembly President shall decide on what action to take in such circumstance, upon confirmation of the Legislative Assembly (De La Salle University Student Council Constitution, Section 11, Article XV).

Wherefore, be it resolved that the Legislative Assembly approve the resignation of the aforementioned Legislative Assembly Representative and Legislative Floor Leader;

Wherefore, be it resolved that one seat for the Legislative Assembly Representative of the College of Computer Studies – CATCH 2T8 be declared vacant effective January 14, 2006;

Wherefore, be it resolved that the Legislative Assembly Floor Leader position be declared vacant;

Wherefore, be it resolved that the College Assembly President of the College of Computer Studies appoint a qualified student for the position, subject to the approval of the Legislative Assembly;

Wherefore, be it further resolved that the Legislative Assembly opens the floor for nomination and election for the new Legislative Assembly Floor Leader;

Wherefore, be it finally resolved that this resolution take effect upon the approval of the Legislative Assembly.
