**RESOLUTION CALLING FOR THE APPROVAL OF THE APPOINTMENT OF THE
COMELEC COMMISSIONER FOR THE COLLEGE OF SCIENCE**

Whereas, there shall be an independent Commission on Elections (COMELEC) which shall decide on all electoral exercises within the university (De La Salle University Student Council Constitution, Article XIV, Section 1);

Whereas, the COMELEC shall be composed of two commissioners from each college of the university (De La Salle University Student Council Constitution, Article XIV, Section 2);

Whereas, a commissioner may be replaced by the College Assembly President through the Legislative Assembly (De La Salle University Student Council Constitution, Article XIV, Section 5.1);

Whereas, Ms. Edna Mendoza, the College Assembly President of COS, has appointed Mr. Norman Rodrigo as the COMELEC commissioner for the College of Science;

Whereas, Mr. Norman Rodrigo has never been placed under any academic or disciplinary probation, has never been a member of any political party, and does not currently hold any other Executive Board positions in any recognized student organization in the university, and therefore meets the qualifications of a COMELEC commissioner (Election Code, Article IV, Section 3).

Wherefore, be it resolved that Mr. Norman Rodrigo be appointed as the new COMELEC commissioner for the College of Science;

Wherefore, be it finally resolved that this resolution take effect upon approval of the Legislative Assembly.
