The title length does not exceed 12-words. The format of the title page follows the example found in the ACM Thesis Instructions.
The pertinent endorsement/approval document is included
The Plagiarism Certificate Summary for the thesis proposal is attached. In the case of the thesis, the Declaration of Originality is attached.
In the final thesis, there is an abstract contained in one-page that accurately summarizes the problem, research design, significant findings, conclusions, and implications.
The Table of Contents (TOC) feature of the word document was used, that utilized leader dots. Single space within levels and double space between levels were consistently used.
There is a separate listing for the tables, figures and appendices. Proper heading format was used.
The definition of terms was presented in alphabetical order using the format in the ACM Thesis Instructions
The APA style in making citations was used.
The APA style in the reference section. Hanging indent were at ¼ tab. Book titles, journal titles, and journal volume numbers are all italicized.
The references had doi's. For electronic versions of articles, the same was noted.

The document was checked for one-to-one relationship, meaning all citations were listed in the reference section and all items in the reference section were cited. It was double-checked to ensure accuracy of author/year for each citation.
The text was printed using a 12-point Times New Roman font
There are two spaces rather than a single space after every sentence/period.
Double space was used within paragraph and four spaces between paragraphs.
Single space was used for long quotations presented in a separate paragraph, within the table entries, in footnotes, endnotes, and in the reference section.
In the thesis proposal, one-inch margins all around were used. For the final thesis, the text did not exceed the margins of the thesis paper.
All paragraphs are indented one tab (equivalent to half an inch or about 12 spaces from the left-hand margin)
All paragraphs are fully justified

Equations, where applicable, are parenthetically numbered consecutively at the right-hand edge of the paper immediately beside the formula
In expressing numbers, words used for numbers one to nine; and, numerical figures for numbers 10 and above, except for special cases.
Each table or figure was introduced in the paragraph immediately before the table or figure presentation.
The table/figure was presented in portrait orientation except where the data could not fit in landscape orientation; in which case, the entire table is on a separate page. Each table/figure is one-page and does not run across more than one-page.
Each table has an Arabic table numeral (tables numbered sequentially). On the next line, there is a descriptive table title, with first letters of main words capitalized, flushed left
Horizontal and vertical lines were removed from tables, except for the top and bottom border. Columns have proper headings.
Each figure has an Arabic table numeral (figures numbered sequentially), followed by a period. After two spaces, the figure has a title. Both "Figure #. Sample Title" are centered across the page.
Table and figure notes presented at the bottom of the table/figure used 10-point Times New Roman font, flushed left.
The active voice is used. The Speller/Grammar feature of the word document was utilized to detect misspelled words and passive voice
There are no one-sentence paragraphs. Neither do paragraphs cover more than half a page.
The document was checked for subject-verb agreement, wordiness, run-on sentences.
There are no orphan or widow statements.
