ORIENTATION FORM: GUIDELINES FOR OFF CAMPUS TEAMBUILDING ACTIVITIES

- 4. No one will be allowed to go beyond the premises of the official venue. Students will only be allowed to leave the resort/property in case of an emergency during which the student/s will be accompanied by the Faculty Adviser/SMO Personnel/Discipline Officer.
- 5. Students are to stay in their assigned rooms after the day's activities.
- 6. Students must not bring/use/consume alcoholic beverages, and illegal substances within the premises of the venue and the vehicle.
- 7. Do not engage in or participate in horseplay, rowdy behavior, and other activities that may cause injury to persons or damage to equipment/property.
- 8. No bringing of weapons, knives, firearms or other tools and equipment that the Faculty Adviser/SMO Personnel/Discipline Officer may deem unsafe for use.
- 9. Students are expected to conduct themselves in a manner compatible with the rules, guidelines, and policies stated in the Student Handbook.
- 10. Participants are expected to follow additional rules, guidelines, and policies that the SMG officers might deem necessary to ensure everyone's safety.
