- Ensures the proper implementation of university policies and regulations related to lost and found items on campus and issues student clearances.
















PROHIBITED DRUGS

No to Prohibited Drugs Policy

Unauthorized bringing in, carrying, possession, and use of prohibited or regulated drugs or chemicals without prescription or any other violation of the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002 (RA 9165) (Major Offense)



Refusal to undergo random drug testing required by the government and the University (Minor Offense)



Accomplished and submit the Drug Testing Consent Form (DTCF).







No Liquor / Gambling / Smoking Policy

Unauthorized bringing in, possession, or drinking liquor or entering the campus under influence of liquor. (Major Offense)

Gambling in any form. (Major Offense)

Smoking, including **e-cigarettes**, inside University premises and within the 5 meter periphery from gates/ fences/ walls of the University, along Agno and Fidel Reyes Sts. until E. Razon Sports Complex Bldg., or and even outside the University during academic functions or school activities. (Minor Offense)
























FORGERY / FRAUD




WEARING OF CORPORATE
















Public Display of Physical Intimacy (PDPI)

- Accessing internet sites that do not correlate to any specific subject or course within the University





No Eating Policy



Minor offense



Eating and drinking other than water, in areas designated as non-eating place such as auditoriums, seminar rooms, classrooms (except light snacks such as biscuits and candies), laboratories, libraries, chapels, and study areas inside the buildings (except SJ Study Area and Gokongwei Lobby).






Clean as You Go (CLAYGO)



Always bring used utensils to the depository areas









Carrying or Possession of Deadly Weapons Inflicting Physical Injury/ Brawls







Unjust enrichment; stealing; failure to turn over lost and found items to the SDFO LFCS.



Vandalism or the deliberate destruction of property belonging to the University or to any member of the academic community.

Scalping or selling of UAAP and other events' tickets at a price higher than the prescribed or approved amount.

Willful failure to comply with summons or notices issued for purposes of investigation conducted in connection with discipline-related offenses



Rape, any form of sexual assault, or abuse (as defined in the 1997 Anti-Rape Law and the Violence Against Women and Children)

Act that causes emotional and psychological distress such as but not limited to annoyance or mischief (Unjust vexation as defined in the Article 287 of Revised Penal Code)

Violation of policies on legal review of contracts and on signatory authority of contracts.



Commission of any cyber crime offense as defined under RA 10175 or the Cybercrime Prevention Act of 2012, such as Cybel-libel, etc.

Acts that bring the name of the University into disrepute, discredit or contempt to the name of the University.



Other Minor Offenses

Playing of electronic, board or card games outside official University activities and academic requirement in the no playing areas.





Bringing in of cutters, pointed scissors and laboratory instruments without necessary permit.





Other Minor Offenses



Loitering along classroom corridors during class hours

Leaving things unattended (Clear-up Drive)





Other Minor Offenses

Unauthorized use of classroom and other school facilities for any purpose without any reservation or proper authorization



Unhygienic and improper use of University facilities









Other Important Provisions

- Jurisdiction on Minor and Major Offenses
- Corrective Measures and Formative Interventions for Minor and Major Offenses

(Please refer to Section 5 of the SHB)



Implications of Having Discipline Infractions

- Accumulation of minor offenses = one major offense.
- A student may be prevented from graduating.
- A student may be disqualified from receiving awards or recognition or from being a Dean's Lister.
- A student may be denied of issuance of Certificate of Good Moral Character.
