




PHYSICS SOCIETY SUMMARY REPORT (A.Y. 2013-2014)

- Member Participation and Appreciation: Member participation increased due to the collaboration with the Physics Department as well as the increase in helpful benefits given to members in order to increase their academic standing. Generally, the members felt like that the organization has been more active than it was, this active participation is due to the increase in students enrolling in Physics subjects as well as the increase in membership.
- Activities: The activities this current year focused more on the core activities of the organizations like academic reviews and studies, competitions, workshops and seminars, and social gatherings.
