

Admission Policies for Applicants with International Credential

International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma / Certificate

IB Diploma

An applicant awarded with an IB Diploma is exempted from taking the DCAT.

IB Certificate

The university may grant credit to the IB Diploma subjects with a minimum requirement of 5 marks.

Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT)

An applicant with a composite score of at least 1500 (old SAT score) in Critical Reading, Mathematics and Writing is exempted from taking the DCAT.

The following criteria will be implemented:

- 1. The applicant must have taken the SAT the year prior to application to DLSU.
- 2. If SAT is taken more than once, applicant must submit the most recent score.
- 3. The High School Grade Point Average (HSGPA) should at least be 80%.
- 4. Recommendations will be used to assess eligibility for admission in DLSU.
- 5. The composite score of the three sections (Critical Reading, Mathematics and Writing) should be at least 1500 (Old SAT Score).

Note: Applicants with New SAT Scores may convert to Old SAT Scores using the College Board website:

GCE A Level

The applicant with the grades of A* and/or A in at least 2 subjects will be exempted from taking the DCAT. These subjects may be credited, subject to evaluation.

GCE AS Level

The university may grant credit to the AS Level subject/s taken, subject to evaluation.

Advanced Placement (AP)

The university may award credit to AP subjects taken with a score of at least 3 in at least 3 courses, subject to evaluation.
