The BS Statistics program major in Actuarial Science (BS STAT) is designed to provide students the necessary background in statistics, mathematics, and computing that allows them to competently practice their profession. It carries a total of 172 academic and 9 non-academic units. The combination of Lasallian Core Curriculum, general, basic, major, specialization, and non-academic courses provides both formal and informal learning opportunities making the program a balanced and interesting one, giving the students an excellent training for the academe, government service, and industry, and a solid foundation to pursue graduate studies in statistics and allied fields.

The program is compliant with CHED Memorandum Order No. 42 Series of 2017 on the policies, standards, and guidelines for the BS Stat program. It also provides opportunity for students to earn credit in the Society of Actuaries (SOA) examination system through their Validation by Educational Experience Program. This acknowledges the inclusion of DLSU in the SOA's Universities and Colleges with Actuarial Programs.
