Semi-Olympic Swimming Pool




- The 8-lane Semi-Olympic swimming pool measures approximately 21 by 25 meters.
- Shower Area for 4 pax are available
- The project aims to strengthen the physical education program of the campus and provide valuable support for athletic and recreational use for the community.

Teaching Laboratory Building



 The Teaching Laboratory Building is a 5story building consisting of 25 laboratory rooms that utilize high-precision equipment for laboratory work for programs under Human Biology, Molecular and Cellular Biology, Chemistry and Biochemistry, Physics, Industrial Engineering, and Industrial Ecology.





University Hall



- The University Hall is a 4-storey structure with an approximate total floor area of 8,000 sqm, wherein learning facilities are equipped w/ the latest lighting, acoustic, and technology-related tools for modern learning
- Together with the Enrique K. Razon Jr. Hall, the University hall are on-track to become the first LEED-certified school building in the country
- The University Hall will cater to the following spaces:
 - Main Canteen & Dining Hall
 - Research Commons
 - Student Hubs
 - Modern Learning Classrooms (40 pax)
 - Collaborative Modern Learning Classrooms (40 pax)
 - Computer Labs
 - Faculty Center and Lounge
 - Innovation Zone
 - Campus Medical Clinic
 - Security Office

St. La Salle Avenue & Br. Andrew Road





- St. Lasalle Avenue 260-meter avenue connecting the College Sector and Integrated School Community.
- Br. Andrew Road 330-Meter road serving as access road to the University Hall and Enrique K. Razon Jr. Hall, and the proposed dormitory, from Ayala Land's Broadfield District.
- Planting Strips, Bike Lanes, and Sidewalks are incorporated in the road network design to promote sustainable mobility on campus


Track Oval & Football Field (Artificial Turf)



- The Track Oval & Football Field (Artificial Turf) measures approximately 15,978 sqm.
- Compliant with the IAAF and FIFA standards
- Utilizes artificial turfing for easier maintenance
- Serves as training grounds for DLSU studentathletes who compete sports competitions at the national and international level.


Football Field (Natural Turf)





- Serves as training grounds for DLSU studentathletes and for Physical Education classes
- Includes bleacher stairs with an approximate seating capacity of 370 pax, with comfort rooms and dressing rooms

- Serves as training grounds for DLSU studentathletes and for Physical Education classes
