

24/7 Permit for Academic and Research Purposes

Policy for Undergraduate Students

The University policy for undergraduate students staying beyond 10 PM/overnight or 24/7 in the laboratories for academic and research purposes states:


“Because of security and safety issues, the case of undergraduate students is unique, and so the associated policy and procedure for them are necessarily more strict. For example, waiver forms are required of undergraduate students, and a maximum of two consecutive days/nights can be applied for in a single permit.”


COS imposes an addendum to the general policy specific to COS undergraduate students:


The presence of the thesis adviser/faculty-in-charge is required in every overnight stay of an undergraduate student.






