Breast examination will be done to female students to detect abnormal breast mass. Palpation (using of hand to examine) of the armpit area and the breast will be done. Female students will be examined by a female doctor. 6 Chest X-Ray	Open space between Br. Connon Hall and Food Basket Canteen	This examination detects lung infections such as pulmonary TB and pneumonia, chest tumor, abnormal accumulation of gas or fluid in the chest, foreign body in the airway.	All forms of metals attached to the chest (e.g. necklace) should be removed prior to the examination. *Female students who are or may be pregnantshould not undergo this examination. Students with chest x-ray done from 04 September 2023 onwards may be exempted from this examination. However, they are required to bring the official result of their recent chest x-ray during PHEx schedule. Chest x-ray results will be available at the x-ray van after 7 working days.
