**Frequently Asked Questions
DLSU Integrated School
(Nursery to Grade 10)
Application AY 2026-2027**

1. When will the application period start?

The application period will be from October 15, 2025 onwards.

2. How will the application process start?

The initial step is to create an account via the new application portal **DLSU Archers Hub**.

3. Will there be an admissions examination?

Yes, there will be an in person admissions examination for all AY 2026-2027 applicants.

4. What are the eligibility requirements to qualify for entry to Nursery - Grade 10?

The applicant may qualify based on the minimum requirements:

1. Age Requirement for Nursery and Kinder Applicants
 - Nursery applicants must be at least 4 years old by **December 31, 2026**.
 - Kinder applicants must be at least 5 years old by **December 31, 2026**.
2. Admission Test and Grade Requirement
 - Must pass the Admissions Test
 - Must have a General Average of at least 85 and above or its letter grade equivalent
 - Must not have a grade of below 80 or its equivalent in any subject including Conduct / Deportment

5. When and how will the application results be released?

A notification will be sent via registered email to access results in the application portal.

6. What will deem my application invalid?

DLSU has the right to invalidate applications with false information and/or fraudulent documentation submitted through email. The applicant may also be permanently disbarred from pursuing any level of study at the university.

7. How much is the tuition and fees and other inclusions?

Tuition and fees vary depending on the grade level; total amount ranges from **Php135,000 to Php155,000** for the current academic year. A sample assessment includes tuition and fees (miscellaneous and special) only. The books (**mostly electronic for Grades 5 to 10**) and uniforms are available in the bookstore.

8. What are the payment plans available?

The payment plans are follows:

- Plan A – Annual/Full
- Plan B – Semi Annual
- Plan C – Quarterly
- Plan D – Monthly



9. Will there be scholarship opportunities for Nursery to Grade 10 applicants?

Currently, there are no scholarship grants offered to new students.

10. What will be the learning modes for AY2026-2027?

DLSU-IS will remain on blended learning mode. However, most days of the week will be allotted to face to face classes.

11. When will be the opening of classes?

Tentatively, it will start by June 2026.

14. What are the Enrollment Requirements for AY2026-2027?

1. **Original** PSA/NSO Birth Certificate
** If the birth certificate is not PSA/NSO issued, it must have an English translation and Apostillized or Red Ribboned by a competent authority from the country where it originated.*
2. **Original** Final Report Card (most recent)
** If report card was issued abroad or by a non DepEd institution, it must be Apostillized/Red Ribboned by a competent authority from the country where it originated.*
3. **Original** ECCD Checklist (for incoming Grade 1 students only)
