## **Admission Policies for Applicants with International Credential**

### **International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma / Certificate**

#### IB Diploma

An applicant awarded with an IB Diploma is exempted from taking the DCAT.

#### IB Certificate

The university may grant credit to the IB Diploma subjects with a minimum requirement of 5 marks.

*Note: The Diploma/Certificate must be awarded by an educational institution that administers the IB Program for at least two (2) years.*

### **Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT)**

An applicant with a Total Score of at least 1100 is exempted from taking the DCAT.

The following criteria will be implemented:

1. The applicant must have taken the SAT the year prior to application to DLSU.
2. If SAT is taken more than once, applicant must submit the most recent score.
3. The High School Grade Point Average (HSGPA) should at least be 80% based on the submitted [Secondary Scholastic Records Form](#).
4. Recommendations will be used to assess eligibility for admission in DLSU, if needed.
5. The composite score of the two sections ("Reading and Writing" and "Math") should be at least 1100.

## **Cambridge International AS & A Level and Cambridge AICE Diploma**

### **GCE A Level**

A Cambridge AICE Diploma or an A Level GCE with a minimum grade of B in at least 3 subjects will be exempted from taking the DCAT. These subjects may be credited, subject to evaluation.

### **GCE AS Level**

The university may grant credit to the AS Level subject/s taken, subject to evaluation.

### **Advanced Placement (AP)**

The university may award credit to AP subjects taken with a score of at least 3 in at least 3 courses, subject to evaluation.
