Guidelines for Direct Admission of La Salle Senior High School Students to De La Salle University

ACADEMY LANE

The Academy Lane is exclusive for applicants who enrolled at **DLSU Senior High School (Manila and Laguna Campuses)** in Grades 11 and 12.

Based on the official Help Desk Announcement from the Provost Office on Progression from Senior High School to College released on 4 September 2024, applicants from DLSU Senior High School of Manila and Laguna Campuses are reminded to observe the following guidelines:

1. DLSU SHS students who were admitted to DLSU SHS (Manila and Laguna campuses) without conditions and have a Grade 11 CGPA of at least 2.00 may apply for admission to DLSU college programs through the Academy Lane of the DLSU Online Admission Facility (OAF). Admission of these DLSU SHS students to specific college degree programs shall be based on the students' grades in SHS.
2. DLSU SHS students with a Grade 11 CGPA lower than 2.00, as well as DLSU SHS students who were accepted with conditions, should apply through the Regular Lane for admission to DLSU college programs. Applicants in the Regular Lane of the DLSU OAF will be screened based on the DLSU College Admission Test (DCAT) and their High School GPA.
3. DLSU SHS students should expect to upload a signed Use of Data Consent Form as part of accomplishing their OAF. This Data Consent Form will be released by ORBE (formerly OASIS) and enables ORBE to transmit the applicant grades directly to OAS.

CONNECT-ED LANE

The Connect-Ed Lane is only for applicants who took the DSHAPE for prequalification and college admission purposes and are enrolled at **DLS-Zobel High School or La Salle Green Hills** in Grades 11 and 12.

1. DSHAPE passers will receive their (DSHAPE Program) Prequalification Letter, and automatically be accepted to DLSU for program choices listed on their Prequalification Letter, provided they obtain at least 80% HSGPA in Grade 11.

For DSHAPE Passers who will apply for programs indicated in the Prequalification Letter

2. Students who **opt to use their DSHAPE scores** must upload the Prequalification Letter through the OAF.
3. DSHAPE passers should expect to upload a signed Use of Data Consent Form as part of accomplishing their applications through the Online Application Facility (OAF). Keep in mind that the Data Consent Form will be in the DLSU format, following the guidelines stated in the OAF.

For Others

4. DSHAPE passers who wish to be accepted to **other programs not listed** on their Prequalification Letter can take the DCAT via the Regular Lane. Please skip the upload button (for exemption from DCAT) to be issued a test permit.
5. Students who fail the DSHAPE are **required** to take the DCAT via the Regular Lane.
6. Admission of applicants via the Regular Lane will be based on DCAT results, school academic records, and other criteria.

Applicants who are eligible to apply through the Academy Lane and the Connect-Ed Lane will receive their application status earlier than the regular batch. Further information will be given to applicants once their submitted applications through the OAF are verified complete by the Office of Admissions and Scholarships (OAS).
