# JAPANESE LANGUAGE

Japanese Language Program is 3-weeks intensive and divided into the following 4 class levels\*:

100 min daily  $\times$  3 classes  $\times$  14 days (3 credits)

- \*1-4 indicates the level of each course. Students will be informed of their level after completing the application process.
