



Sai Gon Tech. Univ. Alumni Survey on Career outcomes

Saigon Technology Univ. is a private university founded in 1997. At present we offer 8 undergraduate programs, 2 joint programs with Troy University, 1 Master program, totaling 7-8 thousands students.

Quality assurance has been emphasized significantly in the last 3 years. Surveys were conducted to gather data on three main factors: students' satisfaction of educational service provided by the university, teaching and operation staff's satisfaction with their working environment, and most importantly alumni's career prospect after graduation. The majority of our programs are technology-based, whose graduates are targeted for competitive job markets - small and medium enterprises in Ho Chi Minh city and neighboring provinces.

We use a data-driven approach to design, adjust, scale, and apply our education solutions in order to stay relevant with the industry. Thus, our focus is on surveying our alumni' career after one year from graduation from all programs.

We aim to learn:

- + Percentage of graduates employed
- + Percentage of graduates employed in industries that correspond to their education program
- + Distribution among public, private and self-employed sectors
- + Average income of graduates
- + Number of different jobs taken by a graduate during this period
- + Self-perceived missing soft skills etc.

The result collected is sent to all programs and departments to facilitate their analysis and assessment processes. From there, informed adjustments to recruitment and teaching can be made e.g. supplying students with soft skills that benefit their self-education and job-search.
