

## Science Foundation Publication Incentives for AY 2018-2019

(As approved by the University Research Council in AY 2016-2017)

Level 4	P75,000	P50,000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>WoS (ISI) eligibility to be limited to citation indices of WoS (i.e., SCI, SSCI and ESCI) and to exclude Zoological Record.</li> <li>Journals in this tier are from those listed in Q3 and Q4 of Scimago.</li> <li>For CCS, Q2 conference proceedings are included in this tier.</li> </ul>
Level 5**	n/a	P25,000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Journals in the ASEAN Citation Index/CHED Journal Incentive Program.</li> <li>Scopus-indexed conference proceedings, except for specific categories listed in higher tiers.</li> <li>Book chapters</li> </ul>
Maiden publication incentive	n/a	P100,000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Given in addition to the regular incentive for a faculty member's first DLSU-affiliated publication in Levels 1 – 4.</li> <li>Faculty members who have not published work in Levels 1 – 4 for at least 10 years are also eligible to apply for this incentive.</li> </ul>

\*Publications in this category are entitled to receive additional support (e.g., for page charges, etc.) under a separate grant from Science Foundation.

\*\*For financial incentive purposes, serial titles that publish only conference papers are classified in Level 5, even if the serial title is listed as a journal in Scopus. Articles in journal special issues drawn from conferences may only be classified in higher tiers if it can be shown that the conference paper in the proceedings is a distinct publication from the full journal paper. In the latter case, a faculty member should opt to avail only of the larger incentive.

\*\*\*To encourage research mentoring of (non-faculty) students, the latter will not be counted when computing the divisor for the faculty's share of the incentive. Faculty members must submit students' ID numbers as part of the documentation. This provision is not valid for the case of students who have become faculty members since receiving their degrees.

\*\*\*\*In the case of publications indexed by WoS (i.e., SCI, SSCI and ESCI) but not by Scopus, classification may be determined based on benchmarking with eligible publications in the same discipline with equivalent Impact Factor. Evidence of the latter must be submitted by the faculty member upon application.
