APPLICATION FOR GRANT DLSU Science Foundation Visiting Scholar Subsidy

A faculty member may apply for the Visiting Scholar Subsidy of **US\$600** to:

- Visit a foreign university in Asia with the purpose of setting up a collaborative research project with the professors of a foreign university and
- Conduct meetings for development of a collaborative research project that will be funded by an international agency.

To qualify, the faculty member must satisfy the following:

- > He/She is a full-time teaching faculty member of DLSU.
- > He/She must have published in an international abstracted journal within the last three (3) years.
- > He/She must present evidence of preliminary correspondence between the faculty and the foreign professor(s) about the plan for collaborative project and a good prospect for obtaining international funding.
- > The product of the meeting must be a project proposal submitted for funding to an international agency that would yield a series of international publications involving the faculty member.
- ► He/She must obtain official permission to travel. (Attach approval from Provost).
- He/She has updated his/her DLSU Faculty Web page (first time applicant must attach the printout of the updated faculty webpage)
