APPLICATION FOR GRANT

A faculty member may apply for funding to cover registration fees to present a paper in an international conference. This grant can only be availed of once an academic year for a maximum amount of **US\$800**. To qualify, the faculty member must satisfy the following:

- ➤ He/She is a full-time teaching faculty member or ASF of DLSU.
- ➤ He/She must have an **accepted paper** to be presented in an international conference.
- > He/She has, as evidence of recent research activity, a journal article or equivalent research output published in the same calendar year as the conference, or in the previous one.
- He/She must obtain official permission to attend the conference. (Please attach approval from Provost) He/She has updated his/her DLSU Faculty Web page (first time applicant must attach the printout of the updated faculty webpage)
